Every ten years following the U.S. Census, the Los Angeles City Charter requires that district boundaries for the City Council be redrawn so that each district is substantially equal in population.

Redistricting is the process that strengthens the governance of the City of Los Angeles by empowering its communities to have their diverse needs served through the redrawing of new council district boundaries for purposes of fair and inclusive representation.

The purpose of these public hearings is to create the space for community members to provide valuable input by describing their communities and helping to shape council district boundaries in order to ensure democracy.
