CITY COUNCIL TAKES ACTION REGARDING AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND LABOR STANDARDS FOR GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENTS AND ZONING CHANGES INITIATIVE ORDINANCE PETITION

LOS ANGELES (June 29, 2016) — Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that the *Affordable Housing and Labor Standards for General Plan Amendments and Zoning Changes* initiative ordinance will appear on the November 8, 2016 ballot.

On June 8, 2016, the initiative petition requesting adoption of the proposed ordinance was presented to the City Council. Pursuant to Charter Section 452(b)(3), the City Council has determined to submit the initiative ordinance, without alteration, to a vote of the electors of the City at the November 8, 2016 Statewide General Election to be conducted by the County of Los Angeles.

The Official Title and Question is as follows:

AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND LABOR STANDARDS FOR GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENTS AND ZONING CHANGES. INITIATIVE ORDINANCE ____.

Shall an ordinance: 1) requiring that certain residential development projects provide for affordable housing and comply with prevailing wage, local hiring and other labor standards; 2) requiring the City to assess the impacts of community plan changes on affordable housing and local jobs; 3) creating an affordable housing incentive program for developments near major transit stops; and 4) making other changes; be adopted?
