FILING PERIODS BEGIN FOR CANDIDATE DECLARATION OF INTENTION AND NOMINATING PETITIONS

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that candidate filing periods for the 2017 City of Los Angeles Primary Nominating Election are fast approaching. Potential candidates must file a Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate and submit a qualifying nominating petition in order to appear on the March 7, 2017, Primary Nominating Election ballot.

All candidates must file their Declaration of Intention and nominating petitions at the Election Division during the periods as noted below:

Declaration of Intention Filing Period:

November 7 - 11, 2016*

Nomination Petition Filing Period:

November 12 - December 7, 2016**

*During the Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate filing period, the Election Division will be open Friday, November 11, 2016, during the Veteran's Day holiday and one Saturday **only**: Saturday, November 12, 2016, from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

** During filing for the Nominating Petition, the Election Division will be closed on Thursday, November 24, 2016, and Friday, November 25, 2016, for the Thanksgiving holiday.

The Office of the City Clerk administers elections for the City of Los Angeles, the Los Angeles Unified School District, and the Los Angeles Community College District. The City’s Primary Nominating Election will be held March 7, 2017, and the General Municipal Election will be held May 16, 2017.
