## CITY OF LOS ANGELES TO CONSOLIDATE THE PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION WITH LOS ANGELES COUNTY 2017 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that the March 7, 2017 Primary Nominating Election will be consolidated onto the Los Angeles County's Consolidated, Municipal and Special Elections that will include a County measure.

On Tuesday, December 6, 2016, the County Board of Supervisors voted in favor of a measure that precipitated a countywide election to be held with the nearest election. Such election was determined to coincide with the City's Primary Nominating Election.

The consolidation includes the County performing poll worker recruitment, polling place recruitment, Election Day operations, ballot recovery, and vote tallying for the City. Additionally, the Random Alphabet Drawing will be determined by the Secretary of State's Office for the County on December 15, 2016.
