RANDOM ALPHABET DRAWING TO DETERMINE CANDIDATES' ORDER ON BALLOT 2017 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that her office will hold a public drawing to determine the order that candidates in the 2017 General Municipal Election will appear on the May 16, 2017 ballot. The drawing will be at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 16, 2017, in the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division, located at the Piper Technical Center, 555 Ramirez Street, Space 300, Los Angeles, CA 90012.

At the event, the City Clerk will randomly draw alphabet letters. The sequence in which the letters are drawn will constitute the order candidates' names will be listed under each office in races for the citywide seats of Mayor, Controller, City Attorney, Los Angeles City Council, and the Los Angeles Unified School District Board of Education, if no candidate receives a majority of the votes in the March 7, 2017, Primary Nominating Election.

The Office of the City Clerk will release the list of candidates who will proceed to a runoff election once the results of the Primary Nominating Election are certified.
