## LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE 2017 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds eligible residents they must register to vote by Tuesday, February 21, 2017,\* in order to be able to vote in the March 7, 2017 Primary Nominating Election. To be eligible to vote, a person must be a citizen of the United States, be 18 years old by Election Day, and not in prison or on parole for a felony. Registered voters who have moved or changed their names since the last election must re-register to vote.

Voter registration is handled by the Office of the California Secretary of State. You can register to vote from the following sources:

- Complete your registration online at [registertovote.ca.gov](http://registertovote.ca.gov)
- Register in person at the Office of the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC), 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, CA 90650.
- Voter registration forms may also be available at the public counter of most Los Angeles City and County buildings, libraries, fire stations, post offices, and Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) offices.

\*A voter may register and vote under conditional voter registration during the period of 14 days prior to Election Day through and including Election Day. An individual can go to the office of their county elections official to conditionally register to vote and vote a provisional ballot. This process is called Conditional Voter Registration (CVR). In order to conditionally register, the individual must first complete an affidavit of registration (also known as a Voter Registration Card). After that they are given a CVR provisional ballot to vote. A voter can locate his/her polling place and view the Official Sample Ballot for the March 7, 2017 Primary Nominating Election (available in English and 12 Federally and City-mandated languages including Armenian, Chinese, Farsi, Hindi, Japanese, Khmer, Korean, Russian, Spanish, Tagalog, Thai, and Vietnamese) by visiting the Los Angeles County RR/CC website at [lavote.net/LOCATOR](http://lavote.net/LOCATOR). City of Los Angeles ballot measure information is contained in the Voter Information Pamphlet available at: [clerk.lacity.org/elections](http://clerk.lacity.org/elections).

The City's Primary Nominating Election will be held March 7, 2017, and the General Municipal Election will be held May 16, 2017. The Office of the City Clerk administers elections for the City of Los Angeles, the Los Angeles Unified School District and the Los Angeles Community College District. However, the March 7, 2017, election will be conducted by the County as part of their Consolidated Municipal and Special Elections.
