LAST DAY TO APPLY FOR A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT 2017 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that applications for a Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballot for the March 7, 2017 Primary Nominating Election must be received by the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (LA RR/CC) on Tuesday, February 28, 2017.

The City's Primary Nominating Election will be held March 7, 2017, and the General Municipal Election will be held May 16, 2017. However, the March 7, 2017, election will be conducted by the County as part of their Consolidated Municipal and Special Elections.
