Voting on Election Day

The polling place location can be found on the back of the Official Sample Ballot (OSB) cover or on the LA County website. Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. Vote By Mail (VBM) voters who have a VBM ballot but don't have time to mail it back in time, can drop off their VBM ballot at any polling place by 8:00 p.m. or at the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk's (LA RR/CC), 12400 Imperial Hwy., Norwalk, CA 90650 **by the close of polls (8:00 p.m.) on Election Day, March 7, 2017**. VBM ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within three days.

The City's Primary Nominating Election will be held March 7, 2017, and the General Municipal Election will be held May 16, 2017. The Office of the City Clerk administers elections for the City of Los Angeles, the Los Angeles Unified School District and the Los Angeles Community College District. However, the March 7, 2017, election will be conducted by the County as a Consolidated Municipal and Special Elections.
