## LAST DAY TO APPLY FOR A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT 2017 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that applications for a Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballot for the May 16, 2017 General Municipal Election must be received by Tuesday, May 9, 2017.

### Returning Voted VBM Ballots

Voters who choose to mail in their VBM ballot must do so early enough to ensure that it arrives in the Election Division office no later than **by the close of polls (8:00 p.m.) on Election Day, May 16, 2017**; however, in accordance with State and City election code, the City Clerk will accept VBM ballots that are signed and postmarked by Election Day and received within three days of the Election.

Voters who cannot mail their VBM ballots in time may drop off their ballot at any polling place or at the Election Division office by the close of polls on Election Day.

### In-Person Voting

Voters may also receive a VBM ballot in person at the Office of the City Clerk, Election Division
