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COLLECTION DEPOTS AND CENTRAL BALLOT PROCESSING LOCATION 2017 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that, in preparation for the May 16, 2017 General Municipal Election, the Office of the City Clerk has secured 35 collection depot (depot) locations throughout the City of Los Angeles and LAUSD election jurisdiction.

On Election Night, after the polls have closed, voted ballots will be taken from over 1,360 individual precincts to these 35 depots. The voted ballots will be packed into ballot bags at the depots and transported to the Election Operations Center located at Piper Technical Center, 555 Ramirez Street, Space 375, Los Angeles, CA 90012. The Election Operations Center will serve as the central location for receipt, processing, and counting of all ballots on Election Night.
