ELECTION NIGHT RESULTS BULLETINS (UNOFFICIAL RESULTS) 2017 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced that the Office of the City Clerk will issue Election Night bulletins with unofficial results for the May 16, 2017 General Municipal Election beginning with Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballots at approximately 8:30 p.m. that evening. Starting at approximately 9:30 p.m., at-poll bulletins will be issued in 15 to 20 minute intervals until all precincts are accounted for.

The first bulletin that evening will contain results from VBM ballots received and processed prior to Election Day. Subsequent bulletins will contain updated results from at-poll ballots as they come in throughout Election Night. A copy of the unofficial results bulletin format is attached for your reference.

Interested parties may obtain unofficial election results throughout Election Night on Los Angeles CityView Channel 35 or by visiting the City Clerk's election website at clerk.lacity.org/elections. For all media-related inquiries on Election Night, please call (213) 978-3281.
