## Outstanding Ballots To Be Processed 2017 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today an initial estimate of **outstanding ballots to be processed** during the official canvass period.

The initial estimate includes Provisional and Vote-By-Mail ballots collected at the polls, as well as Vote-By-Mail ballots received in the mail after Friday, May 12, 2017. The City Clerk will continue to accept additional Vote-By-Mail ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received by Friday, May 19, 2017. These additional ballots are not reflected in the estimates below.
