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ELECTION CANVASS NEARS COMPLETION - FINAL TALLY SCHEDULED FOR MAY 26, 2017 2017 GENERAL NOMINATING ELECTION

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that the Official Canvass of the May 16, 2017 General Municipal Election, which began on May 17, 2017, is nearing completion. The final tally of all outstanding ballots is scheduled to begin on May 26, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. Following the final tally, the City Clerk will certify the results and prepare a report for the City Council to declare the results. The City Council is expected to schedule the report shortly thereafter.

The final tally will take place in Space 375 of Piper Technical Center, located at 555 Ramirez Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012.
