REGIONAL CANDIDATE FILING OPENS FOR NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL ELECTIONS

LOS ANGELES (December 24, 2018) – City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announces the commencement of the 2019 Neighborhood Council Elections Candidate Filing.

To implement the candidate filing phase for the upcoming Neighborhood Council elections, the City Clerk enhanced its online module to ease the filing process for potential candidates. The neighborhood elections will be conducted over several months on a rolling regional basis.

Election Regions:	1 through 13
Candidate Filing Dates:	December 16, 2018 – April 8, 2019*

- ✓ There are 99 Neighborhood Councils, of which **94 are holding elections**.
- ✓ Neighborhood Councils are clustered to form 13 election regions.
- ✓ Each region has its own candidate filing deadline and unique Election Day.*
