## CITY CLERK APPROVES REFERENDUM PETITION FOR CIRCULATION

### MINIMUM WAGE FOR EMPLOYEES WORKING AT HEALTHCARE FACILITIES

LOS ANGELES (**July 14, 2022**) — Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that a petition for a referendum against Ordinance 187566 was approved by the Office of the City Clerk on July 14, 2022, for circulation and collection of signatures of registered voters in the City of Los Angeles.

In accordance with Charter Section 461(a), all names signed to the petition must have been secured within 30 days after publication of the ordinance. Ordinance 187566 was published on July 13, 2022. The petition must be signed by 40,717\* registered voters of the City of Los Angeles and filed with the Office of the City Clerk no later than August 12, 2022.

The Office of the City Clerk administers candidate filing for the City of Los Angeles and the Los Angeles Unified School District.
