### **CITY COUNCIL TAKES ACTION ON REFERENDUM AGAINST ORDINANCE NO. 187566 (HEALTHCARE WORKERS MINIMUM WAGE)**

LOS ANGELES **LOS ANGELES (September 30, 2022)** — Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that the City Council took action in response to a certified referendum petition to submit Ordinance No. 187566 (Healthcare Workers Minimum Wage) to the voters at the City's Primary Nominating Election to be held on March 5, 2024.

On September 15, 2022, the certified referendum petition against Ordinance No. 187566 was presented to the City Council requiring a referendary vote on the Ordinance. Pursuant to Charter, the City Council has determined to submit the ordinance to the voters of the City of Los Angeles for a referendary vote at the March 5, 2024 Primary Nominating Election, to be conducted by the County of Los Angeles.
