CANDIDATE FILING PRESENTATIONS AVAILABLE ONLINE 2023 COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 SPECIAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (November 29, 2022) — Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced that a two part series of candidate filing presentations are now available on the City Clerk's website. The presentations provide instructions for the City's candidate filing process to run for office in the upcoming April 4, 2023, City of Los Angeles Special Election Council District 6.

The presentation videos detail the processes related to filing the Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate and filing Nominating Petitions, which are required for candidates to qualify for the ballot. The City Clerk strongly recommends that all potential candidates view these candidate presentations before filing. Presentations can be viewed on our website at:

The candidate filing period for the upcoming April 4, 2023, City of Los Angeles Special Election Council District 6 will begin with the first day to file a Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate and the first day to pick up Nominating Petitions starting December 5, 2022. Although the City Clerk's Office is open for in-person services, appointments are recommended. Appointments can be made now on a first-come, first-served basis by calling (213) 978-0444.

These City Clerk presentations described above are not substitutes for the separate Ethics Commission candidate and treasurer training sessions which are mandatory for City of Los Angeles' elected seats.
