FILING PERIODS BEGIN FOR 2023 COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 SPECIAL ELECTION CANDIDATE DECLARATION OF INTENTION AND NOMINATING PETITIONS

LOS ANGELES (**December 2, 2022**) – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that the candidate filing period for the 2023 City of Los Angeles Council District 6 Special Election begins December 5, 2022. Interested candidates must file a Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate and submit a qualifying Nominating Petition in order to appear on the April 4, 2023, City of Los Angeles Council District 6 ballot.

All Candidate Filing processes take place in person at the City Clerk’s Election Division Office. Hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. It is recommended to make an appointment. Pursuant to Ordinance 187219, proof of either full COVID-19 Vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test result conducted within the last 72 hours will be required to enter City buildings. To slow the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19), the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division strongly recommends wearing a facemask to enter City buildings. Please note that while it is strongly recommended, it may be required at the time.

Appointments will be available on a first-come, first-served basis starting on December 5, 2022, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Candidates can schedule their appointments and obtain additional information by calling the Election Division during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. or by visiting the City Clerk’s website at: clerk.lacity.org/election.
