### LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 SPECIAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (**March 17, 2023**) – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds eligible residents to register to vote in the April 4, 2023, Council District 6 Special Election. To be eligible to vote, a person must reside in Council District 6, be a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years old by Election Day, and not in prison for a felony. Registered voters who have moved or changed their names since the last election, or would like to change their political party affiliation, must also re-register to vote. The deadline to register to vote in order to receive an Official Sample Ballot and a Vote-By-Mail Ballot in the mail for the Special Election is **Monday, March 20, 2023**.

#### CONDITIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION:

Eligible Council District 6 residents who miss the registration deadline can still vote at any Vote Center in Council District 6. Under California Election Law, Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) allows a prospective voter to register and cast a ballot. For more information please visit:
