ELECTION DAY REMINDER

2023 COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 SPECIAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (**April 4, 2023**) – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds eligible residents that today, Tuesday, April 4, 2023, is Council District 6 Special Election Day. Council District 6 voters can vote at any vote center in the Council District from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

WHERE TO VOTE IN-PERSON:

There are seven Vote Centers open in Council District 6. To find a Vote Center:

- For multilingual assistance, call the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk at (800) 815-2666, option #3.

WHERE TO DROP OFF VOTE-BY-MAIL (VBM) BALLOT:

There are 13 VBM Ballot Drop Boxes available in Council District 6.

- Find the closest Drop Box location at: <https://clerk.lacity.gov/elections>.
- Drop-off your VBM ballot at any Vote Center in Council District 6.
- Voters may also mail their ballot in until Election Day, April 4, 2023 (if postmarked by Election Day and received within seven days).

CONDITIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION:

Eligible Council District 6 residents who miss the registration deadline can still vote at any Vote Center in Council District 6. Under California Election Law, Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) allows a prospective voter to register and cast a ballot. For more information, please visit:
