CANDIDATE FILING PRESENTATIONS AVAILABLE ONLINE 2024 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (**October 17, 2023**) - Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced that a two-part series of presentations, which provide instructions into the City's candidate filing process to run for office in the upcoming March 5, 2024 Primary Nominating Election, are now available on the City Clerk's website.

The presentation videos detail the processes related to filing the Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate and filing nominating petitions, which are required for candidates to qualify for the ballot. The City Clerk recommends that all potential candidates view these candidate presentations before filing.
