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CITY CALLS FOR REQUESTS TO MAKE BALLOT MEASURE ARGUMENTS PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (November 28, 2023) - Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announced today that individuals and organizations who wish to write arguments concerning the City of Los Angeles' measures to appear in the March 5, 2024, Primary Nominating Election, must submit requests to the office of Council President Paul Krekorian no later than 5:00 p.m., Friday, December 1, 2022. Ballot arguments in favor of and against this measure will be published in the Voter Information Pamphlet, which is provided to all registered voters in the City of Los Angeles.

The City Council has approved the following measures to appear on the March ballot:

- City Mobility Plan Street Improvement Measures. Initiative Ordinance SLA.
- Hotel Land Use, Replacement Housing, and Police Permit Requirements; Program Placing Unhoused Individuals in Vacant Hotel Rooms. Initiative Ordinance RHO.

Council President Krekorian will designate applicants from the request pool to be considered by the City Council's Rules and Elections Committee at its special meeting on Tuesday, December 5, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. Designated authors will be notified by the City Clerk and will be provided with the necessary forms and detailed instructions.

The attached letter from Council President Krekorian further explains the ballot measure argument submission process. Also attached is the form to request to be the designated author of a ballot argument in favor of or against a measure.

All Interested Parties:

The City Council has adopted resolutions to submit the following ballot measures to the voters at the City's Primary Nominating Election, consolidated with the County's Statewide Primary Election held on March 5, 2024:

CITY MOBILITY PLAN STREET IMPROVEMENT MEASURES. INITIATIVE ORDINANCE <u>SLA.</u>

HOTEL LAND USE, REPLACEMENT HOUSING, AND POLICE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS; PROGRAM PLACING UNHOUSED INDIVIDUALS IN VACANT HOTEL ROOMS. INITIATIVE ORDINANCE RHO.

Section 605 of the City Election Code specifies that the President of the City Council, with the approval of the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee, may designate a person, persons or association to write arguments and/or rebuttal arguments In Favor of and Against the adoption of measures placed on the ballot.

In making a designation, the President of the City Council shall give preference in the following order: (1) an elected officer of the City; (2) an appointive officer of the City; (3) bona fide associations of citizens; (4) individual voters. Please note, elected officials and City employees submitting ballot arguments do so wholly in their personal capacity. For ordinances proposed by initiative, the Arguments in Favor and Rebuttals to the Arguments Against shall be written by the proponents filing the initiative.

Individuals wishing to be designated to write arguments related to the ballot measure should submit written requests to my office no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 1, 2023. Please use the attached form. A copy of your request should also be forwarded to:
