## LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE 2024 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (February 16, 2024) - Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds eligible residents to register to vote in the March 5, 2024 Primary Nominating Election. To be eligible to vote, a person must be a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years old by Election Day, and not in prison for a felony. Registered voters who have moved or changed their names since the last election, or would like to change their political party affiliation must also re-register to vote. The deadline to register to vote is **Tuesday, February 20, 2024**.

## VOTE-BY-MAIL:

All voters in California, registered by the February 20, 2024 deadline, will automatically be sent a Vote-By-Mail Ballot. There are three ways voters may return their Vote-By-Mail Ballot:

- Mail their ballot by Election Day, March 5, 2024 (Must be postmarked by Election Day and received within seven days).
- Use an Official Vote-By-Mail Drop Box location.
- Find locations at <u>https://locator.lavote.gov/locations/vbm.</u>
- Drop off their ballot at any Vote Center in Los Angeles County.

## CONDITIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION:

Eligible Los Angeles County residents who miss the registration deadline can still vote at any Vote Center in L.A. County. Under California Election Law, Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) allows a prospective voter to register and cast a ballot. For more information please visit:
