EARLY VOTING BEGINS 2024 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (**February 23, 2024**) — Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds eligible voters that in addition to all registered voters in California receiving a Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballot, early in-person voting will be available for the March 5, 2024 Primary Nominating Election, beginning **Saturday, February 24, 2024 through Election Day**.

HOW AND WHERE TO VOTE:

For the March 5, 2024 Primary Nominating Election, voters will have several options to cast their ballots:

- **Vote Center:** Voters can cast or drop-off their voted VBM ballot at any Vote Center throughout the County. Select Vote Centers will be open as early as Saturday, February 24, 2024, and all additional Vote Centers will be open on Saturday, March 2, 2024 through Election Day.
- **Ballot Drop-Box:** Voters can securely drop off their voted VBM ballot at any of the Ballot Drop Box locations throughout the County through Election Day.
- **Mail:** Voters can mail their voted VBM ballot until Election Day (if postmarked by Election Day and received within seven days).

CONDITIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION:

Eligible Los Angeles County residents who missed the February 20, 2024 registration deadline can still vote at any Vote Center in Los Angeles County. Under California Election Law, Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) allows a prospective voter to conditionally register and cast a ballot. For more information please visit:
