**ELECTION DAY REMINDER**  
**2024 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION**

LOS ANGELES (**March 5, 2024**) – Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds voters that today, Tuesday, March 5, 2024, is Primary Nominating Election Day. All registered voters are encouraged to review their Official Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlet before going to vote. Los Angeles County voters can vote at any Vote Center in the County from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. today.

**WHERE TO VOTE:**

To find a Vote Center near you:

- Check your Official Vote Center Postcard.

- Call the City Clerk - Election Division at (213) 978-0444.

**WHERE TO DROP OFF VOTE-BY-MAIL (VBM) BALLOT:**

VBM Ballot Drop Boxes are available around the County.

- Drop-off your VBM ballot at any Vote Center.
- VBM ballots postmarked by Election Day will be counted if received within seven days.

**CONDITIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION (CVR):**

Eligible Los Angeles County residents who missed the February 20, 2024 registration deadline can still vote at any Vote Center in Los Angeles County. Under California Election Law, CVR allows a prospective voter to conditionally register and cast a ballot.
