### **EARLY VOTING BEGINS 2024 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

LOS ANGELES (**October 25, 2024**) — Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott reminds eligible voters that in addition to all registered voters in California receiving a Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballot, in-person voting will be available for the November 5, 2024 General Municipal Election, beginning **Saturday, October 26, 2024 through Election Day**.

#### **HOW AND WHERE TO VOTE:**

Voters will have several options to cast their ballots:

- **Mail:** Voters can mail their voted VBM ballot until Election Day (must be postmarked by Election Day and received within seven days).
- **Ballot Drop-Box:** Voters may securely drop off their voted VBM ballot at any of the Ballot Drop Box locations throughout the County until Election Day at 8:00 p.m. (close of polls).
- **Vote Center:** Voters can vote in-person by casting their ballot at a Ballot Marking Device or drop off their voted VBM ballot at any Vote Center throughout the County. Select Vote Centers will be open as early as Saturday, October 26, 2024, with all additional Vote Centers opening on Saturday, November 2, 2024 through Election Day.

#### **SAME-DAY VOTER REGISTRATION:**

Eligible Los Angeles County residents who missed the October 21, 2024 registration deadline can still vote at any Vote Center in Los Angeles County. Under California Election Law, Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) allows a prospective voter to conditionally register and cast a ballot. For more information please visit:
