# ELECTION REMINDER ALL VOTE CENTERS OPEN NOVEMBER 2, 2024

### 2024 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (November 1, 2024) — Los Angeles City Clerk Holly L. Wolcott announces that all Vote Centers will now be open Saturday, November 2, 2024, through Election Day, November 5, 2024. Run-off candidates for Los Angeles City Council Districts 2, 10, and 14, Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) Board of Education Offices 1, 3, and 5, and the City ballot measures - Charter Amendments DD, LL, HH, II, ER and FF, will be included on the City of Los Angeles ballot.

Voters can cast their ballots at any Vote Center in Los Angeles County, mail in their ballot by Election Day (if postmarked by Election Day and received within seven days), or securely drop off their voted Vote-By-Mail ballot at any Official Drop-Box or Vote Center.

## **SAME-DAY VOTER REGISTRATION:**

Eligible Los Angeles County residents who missed the registration deadline can still vote at any Vote Center in LA County. Under California Election Law, Conditional Voter Registration (CVR) allows a prospective voter to conditionally register and cast a ballot. For more information please visit:
