RANDOM ALPHABET DRAWING RESULTS TO DETERMINE CANDIDATE ORDER ON BALLOT

Los Angeles City Clerk Frank T. Martinez announced today that a public drawing was held on Wednesday, December 13, 2006, at 9:00 a.m. in the City Council Chamber, Room 340 of Los Angeles City Hall, to determine the alphabetical order that candidates' names will appear on the ballot for the Primary Nominating Election on March 6, 2007 and the General Municipal Election on May 15, 2007 (in the event of a run-off). The random sequences in which the alphabet letters were drawn constitutes the order that the candidates' last names for the various City of Los Angeles, Board of Education and Community College elected offices will be listed on the ballot.

Signature verification on candidates' nominating petitions is expected to be completed by Saturday, December 16, 2006. A list of candidates who have qualified for the March 6, 2007 ballot will be certified in the above random alphabetical order.

Although the filing period for the Los Angeles Unified School District Board of Education – District 5 has been extended to December 16, 2006, candidates who qualify for the March 6, 2007 ballot for this office will also be listed in the above random alphabetical order. Signature verification on candidates' nominating petitions for this office is expected to be completed by Tuesday, December 26, 2006.

In addition, please note that there will be a separate random alphabet drawing on January 5, 2007 to determine the order of candidates for the Council District 7 Special Election.
