Los Angeles City Clerk Frank T. Martinez announced today that additional pollworkers are still needed to assist in the upcoming Primary Nominating Election and Council District 7 Special Election to be held on March 6, 2007.


You can help provide a vital service needed in your community by volunteering to be a pollworker. For Election Day service, you will be paid an \$80/\$100 stipend. You are also paid a bonus of \$25 for attending a required two hour training class. Training classes are scheduled throughout the community. In order to become a pollworker, you must be a registered voter.

In an effort to meet the needs of the City of Los Angeles' linguistically diverse electorate and comply with federal requirements, the Election Division is in particular need of bilingual pollworkers. This includes people who can speak both English and one of the six federally-mandated languages (Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Vietnamese).

The Office of the City Clerk – Election Division invites you, your family, and your friends to take part in the electoral process by signing up to be a pollworker for the upcoming 2007 Municipal Elections.


We are especially looking for individuals who speak English and one of the six Federally mandated languages (Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, Vietnamese) or who would like to be an Inspector. Inspectors are in charge of the polling place on Election Day.

On Election Day, pollworkers work from approximately 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Inspectors receive a \$100* stipend. Clerks receive a \$80* stipend. In addition, you will be paid an additional \$25 for attending a mandatory training class, as long as you work on Election Day. Training classes will be scheduled across the City and in your community.

You can make a difference in your community and the lives of your friends and neighbors. Help them participate. Help people vote.

To be a pollworker, you must be:

- At least 18 years old;
- A United States Citizen;
- A registered voter; and
- Able to speak, read and write English or bilingual
