EARLY VOTING BY TOUCHSCREEN IS AVAILABLE FOR THE MARCH 6, 2007 PRIMARY NOMINATING & CONSOLIDATED ELECTIONS AND COUNCIL DISTRICT 7 SPECIAL ELECTION

Los Angeles City Clerk Frank T. Martinez announced today that registered voters can vote early in the scheduled March 6, 2007 Primary Nominating & Consolidated Elections and Council District 7 Special Election using state-certified Touchscreen technology. In partnership with the City of Los Angeles Library Department and the Office of the City Clerk – Election Division, voters will be able to vote early at any one of fourteen libraries as well as City Hall and the Marvin Braude Center beginning February 20, 2007 through March 2, 2007. A list of locations and hours of operation is included for your reference.

Early Voting by Touchscreen is an alternative to voting by mail (absentee voting) and voting on Election Day. When a Touchscreen voter arrives to vote at the early voting location, the voter's registration will be confirmed electronically. Next, the voter will be issued a Voter Access Card, which will program the Touchscreen voting device with the list of candidates to be voted on specifically by that voter. The voter will then be able to vote by touching the screen on the indicated space for the candidates of their choice.

Voters who prefer to vote in one of the six federally-mandated languages (Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Vietnamese) will also be able to vote in their language. In addition, headsets and large scale on-screen text are available for voters with visual or auditory impairments.

Early Voting by Touchscreen is private and secure. The results of Early Voting by Touchscreen will not be released until the close of polls on Election Day, March 6, 2007.
