VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE FOR THE MARCH 6, 2007 PRIMARY NOMINATING & CONSOLIDATED ELECTIONS AND COUNCIL DISTRICT 7 SPECIAL ELECTION

Los Angeles City Clerk Frank T. Martinez reminds residents to register to vote **by Tuesday, February 20, 2007** in order to vote in the 2007 Primary Nominating & Consolidated Elections and Council District 7 Special Election to be held on March 6, 2007. To be eligible to register to vote, residents must be citizens of the United States and 18 years old by Election Day. Registered voters who have moved or changed their names must re-register. Citizens can register or re-register to vote in person at the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder's Office, 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, CA 90650. They may also register by mail using registration forms that can be obtained from public counters in all City and County Departments, libraries, fire stations and the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Voters who would like to receive an Official Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlet (available in seven languages: English, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Vietnamese) may do so by contacting the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division before Friday, March 2, 2007.
