Vote-By-Mail Inspection and Tally

Vote-By-Mail Ballot Inspection (i.e., preparation for the tally) will take place on Friday, March 2, 2007 from 9:00 a.m. until approximately 6:00 p.m. and will continue through the afternoon of Tuesday, March 6, 2007 as necessary. The tally of Vote-By-Mail ballots will occur in the afternoon of March 6, 2007. The results of this tally will not be released until after the close of polls at 8:00 p.m., Tuesday, March 6, 2007.

Early Voting Tally

The tally of Early Voting ballots will be conducted on Saturday, March 3, 2007 at 2:00 p.m. The results of this tally will not be released until after the close of polls at 8:00 p.m., Tuesday, March 6, 2007.

March 6th Election Day Events

Polling places open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m. Precinct Ballots begin to arrive at Piper Technical Center between 8:30 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. Precinct Ballot Inspection begins at 8:30 p.m. and continues until the last precinct ballots arrive at approximately 11:00 p.m. to 12:00 midnight. Ballots will be tallied as they complete the inspection process. Bulletins containing unofficial results, including the Early Voting and Vote-By-Mail ballots, will be issued throughout the night.
