CITY OF LOS ANGELES NEEDS POLLWORKERS FOR THE MAY 15, 2007 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Los Angeles City Clerk Frank T. Martinez announced today that additional pollworkers are still needed to assist in the upcoming General Municipal Election to be held on May 15, 2007.

Help provide a vital service needed in the community by volunteering to be a pollworker. For Election Day service, you will be paid up to an \$80/\$100 stipend and a bonus of \$25 for attending a mandatory two-hour training class. Pollworker training classes are scheduled throughout the community in the weeks prior to Election Day. You must be at least 18 years old by Election Day and a registered voter in order to volunteer to be a pollworker.

Also, in an effort to meet the needs of the City of Los Angeles' linguistically diverse electorate and comply with federal requirements, the Election Division is in particular need of bilingual pollworkers. If you can speak both English and one of the six federally-mandated languages (Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Vietnamese), you are encouraged to volunteer to be a pollworker on Election Day.


We are especially looking for individuals who speak English and one of the six Federally mandated languages (Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, Vietnamese) or who would like to be an Inspector. Inspectors are in charge of the polling place on Election Day.

On Election Day, pollworkers work from approximately 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Inspectors receive a \$100* stipend. Clerks receive a \$80* stipend. In addition, you will be paid an additional \$25 for attending a mandatory training class, as long as you work on Election Day. Training classes will be scheduled across the City and in your community.

You can make a difference in your community and the lives of your friends and neighbors. Help them participate. Help people vote.

To be a pollworker, you must be:

- At least 18 years old;
- A United States Citizen;
- A registered voter; and
- Able to speak, read and write English or bilingual
