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### FIRST DAY TO APPLY FOR A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT FOR THE MAY 15, 2007 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Los Angeles City Clerk Frank T. Martinez announced today that **Monday, April 16, 2007** is the **first day to apply for a Vote-By-Mail Ballot** and the first day to vote in the Election Division Office for the May 15, 2007 General Municipal Election.

In order to receive a Vote-By-Mail Ballot, you must fill out and send in a Vote-By-Mail Application. Vote-By-Mail Applications can be found on the **back cover of your Official Sample Ballot** or on the Election Division website at <http://cityclerk.lacity.org/election/>. Applications in Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Vietnamese are also available on the Election Division website.

The Election Division will continue to receive applications by mail or fax until **5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 8, 2007**.

**Voted** Vote-By-Mail Ballots must be received in the Election Division Office by the close of polls on Election Day (May 15, 2007). Vote-By-Mail ballots may also be dropped off at any polling place on Election Day.

Voting in the Election Division Office begins on Monday, April 16, 2007 and continues through Monday, May 14, 2007.
