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## VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE FOR THE MAY 15, 2007 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Los Angeles City Clerk Frank T. Martinez reminds residents to register to vote **by Monday**, **April 30, 2007** in order to vote in the City of Los Angeles General Municipal Election to be held on May 15, 2007. To be eligible to register to vote, residents must be United States citizens and 18 years old by Election Day. Registered voters who have moved or changed their names must also re-register. Citizens can register or re-register in person at the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder's Office, located at 12400 Imperial Highway, Norwalk, CA 90650. They may also register by mail using registration forms that can be obtained from public counters in all City and County Departments, libraries, fire stations and the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Voters who would like to receive an Official Sample Ballot (available in English and the following six federally-mandated languages: Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Vietnamese) may do so by contacting the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division before Friday, May 11, 2007.
