Vote-By-Mail Applications in the six federally-mandated languages of Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Vietnamese are also available on the Election Division website.

<u>Voted</u> Vote-By-Mail ballots must be received in the Election Division Office by close of polls on Election Day (May 15, 2007). Vote-By-Mail ballots may also be dropped off at any polling place on Election Day.

Voting in the Election Division Office began Monday, April 16, 2007 and continues through Monday, May 14, 2007.
