RESIDENCE DEADLINE FOR CANDIDATES 2009 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

Los Angeles Interim City Clerk Karen E. Kalfayan reminds all candidates for elective City of Los Angeles and Los Angeles Unified School District offices that they must reside in the jurisdiction and applicable district in which they are running for office by <u>October 4, 2008</u>. Failure to meet this residency requirement will disqualify candidates from running for office.

To be eligible for nomination or election, a person must be a <u>registered voter</u> of the City, or of the School or Community College District, in the case of candidates for the Los Angeles Unified School District and Los Angeles Community College District. In addition, candidates for Los Angeles City Offices and Los Angeles Unified School District offices must have been a <u>resident</u> of the applicable City or School District in which they are running for office for at least <u>30 days</u> immediately preceding the first day upon which candidates can file a Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate.
