SEPTEMBER 15th IS THE LAST DAY TO APPLY FOR A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT FOR THE 2009 CITY OF LOS ANGELES COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 SPECIAL ELECTION

Los Angeles City Clerk June Lagmay announced today that the last day to apply for a Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballot for the September 22, 2009 City of Los Angeles Council District 2 Special Election is **5:00 p.m., Tuesday, September 15, 2009**. All applications for Vote-By-Mail ballots must be in the possession of the Office of the City Clerk-Election Division by the September 15, 2009, 5:00 p.m. deadline.

VBM applications can be found on the back cover of the Official Sample Ballot and on the Election Division website at <http://cityclerk.lacity.org/election/>. They are available in English and the six Federally-mandated languages of Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog and Vietnamese.

VBM applications can also be faxed to the Election Division, VBM Section, at fax numbers (213) 978-0611 or (213) 978-0612. The deadline to fax an application similarly is 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 15, 2009.

Consequently, **voted** VBM ballots must be received in the Office of the City Clerk-Election Division by the close of polls (8:00 p.m.) on Election Day, September 22, 2009. Voters can drop off their voted VBM ballots at any polling place on Election Day.

Voters wishing to apply for and/or cast their VBM ballot in person prior to Election Day can do so by coming in to the Office of the City Clerk-Election Division. The Election Division is located at Piper Technical Center, 555 Ramirez Street, Space 300, Los Angeles, CA 90012. This procedure began Monday, August 24, 2009 and will continue through 5:00 p.m., **Monday, September 21, 2009**.
