### SEVEN DAYS LEFT UNTIL THE DECEMBER 8, 2009 CITY OF LOS ANGELES COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 SPECIAL RUNOFF ELECTION

Los Angeles City Clerk June Lagmay announced today that there are **only seven days left until the December 8, 2009 City of Los Angeles Council District 2 Special Runoff Election**. All Council District 2 registered voters are encouraged to review their Official Sample Ballot before going to vote on Tuesday, December 8, 2009.

For this Special Election, the City of Los Angeles has established 109 at-polls precincts staffed by approximately 436 Precinct Board Members. In addition, an estimated 100 workers will be working on Election Night to staff ballot collection depots, drive ballot vehicles, and tabulate the results of the vote. The City Clerk and many community volunteer workers are ready to aid you in casting your ballot on Election Day.

Remember to mark your Official Sample Ballot with your choice, and to take it with you to the polls. **You can find the location of your polling place on the back cover of your Official Sample Ballot.** The polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, December 8, 2009.

The deadlines to register to vote for this election, and to apply for an absentee ballot (Vote-By-Mail), have passed. If you have already received a Vote-By-Mail ballot, it must be filled out, mailed and **received** by the City Clerk's Office by 5:00 p.m. Monday, December 7, 2009. You may also take your completed Vote-By-Mail ballot to your polling place, or any polling place, on Election Night, December 8, 2009.
