NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF THE LOS ANGELES 2011 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS GENERAL INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES PAMPHLET

Los Angeles City Clerk June Lagmay announced today that the General Information for Candidates pamphlet for the 2011 City Primary Nominating and General Municipal Elections is now available. This pamphlet provides vital information and legal deadlines for individuals interested in becoming a candidate for Los Angeles City Council Districts 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12 and 14 (even-numbered); Los Angeles Unified School District, Board of Education Offices 1, 3, 5 and 7, and Los Angeles Community College District Seats 1, 3, 5 and 7 (odd-numbered).

The Primary Nominating Election will be held on Tuesday, March 8, 2011 and the General Municipal Election (runoff) will be held on Tuesday, May 17, 2011. Candidates who are interested in running for City Council offices must live in the respective Council District by October 9, 2010. The filing period for the Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate begins Monday, November 8, 2010 and ends Saturday, November 13, 2010 at noon. The period for gathering signatures for nominating petitions begins Saturday, November 13, 2010 (City Clerk-Elections will be open until noon only) and ends Wednesday, December 8, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. Our office will be closed for the Thanksgiving holidays on Thursday, November 25, 2010 and Friday, November 26, 2010.
