**CERTIFIED RESULTS FOR THE
MARCH 8, 2011 PRIMARY NOMINATING AND CONSOLIDATED ELECTIONS**

Los Angeles (March 25, 2011) City Clerk June Lagmay announced today that the Certified Results for the March 8, 2011, City of Los Angeles Primary Nominating and Consolidated Elections have been released and can be viewed on the Office of the City Clerk-Election Division website at: <http://cityclerk.lacity.org/election/>. A copy of the Certified Results is also attached to this notice.

The Certified Results will be submitted to the Los Angeles City Council which shall declare the results of the Primary Election and the runoff candidates for two races in the upcoming General Municipal Election. Runoff elections for Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) Office No. 5 and Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) Seat No. 5 will take place on Tuesday, May 17, 2011.

Candidates were elected to the offices of City Council in Districts 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, and 14; LAUSD Offices 1, 3, and 7, and LACCD Seats 1, 3, and 7.

The final bulletin includes election results for the City of Los Angeles, the LAUSD, the LACCD, and another final bulletin presents combined totals from the other cities that conducted consolidated elections with the City of Los Angeles.
