**LAST DAY TO FILE CANDIDATE DECLARATION OF INTENTION  
AND FIRST DAY TO FILE NOMINATING PETITIONS  
COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 SPECIAL ELECTION**

**LOS ANGELES** (January 31, 2013) – Los Angeles City Clerk June Lagmay reminds all potential candidates for the Council District 6 Special Election that the last day to file a Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate is **Saturday, February 9, 2013 at 12:00 p.m.**

In order to appear on the May 21, 2013 Council District 6 Special Election ballot, candidates for Council District 6 must file a Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate and submit a qualifying nominating petition.

Please note that candidates may **obtain** their nominating petitions after they file their Declaration of Intention beginning February 4, 2013. However, the period for **filing** the nominating petitions begins **8:00 a.m. Saturday, February 9, 2013** and ends **5:00 p.m. Monday, February 25, 2013.**

To summarize, all candidates must file their Declaration of Intention and nominating petitions at the Election Division during the periods as noted below:

**Nomination Petition Filing Period:**

February 9 - 25, 2013\*\*

\*For filing the Declaration of Intention to Become a Candidate, the Election Division will be open on one Saturday: February 9, 2013 from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

\*\*During filing for the nominating petition, the Election Division will be closed on Monday, February 18, 2013 for the Presidents Day holiday.
