## Audio Recordings

The Office of the City Clerk - Election Division produces and provides audio recordings of the Official Sample Ballot for visually-impaired voters and any other interested individuals. The recordings are available in both cassette and CD format and are available in English and the eight Federally-mandated languages: Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, Thai, and Vietnamese.
