**2013 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION**

**LOS ANGELES** (February 25, 2013) — City Clerk June Lagmay announced that the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division will issue Election Night bulletins with unofficial results for candidates and measures for the March 5, 2013 City of Los Angeles Primary Nominating Election beginning at approximately 8:30 p.m. on Election Night. The first bulletin will contain results from the Vote-By-Mail ballots received and processed prior to Election Day. Subsequent bulletins will contain updated results from at-polls ballots as they come in throughout Election Night. A copy of the unofficial results bulletin format is attached for your reference.
