2013 PRIMARY NOMINATING ELECTION

LOS ANGELES (March 5, 2013) — City Clerk June Lagmay reminds voters to get out and vote today, Tuesday March 5, 2013, in the City of Los Angeles Primary Nominating Election. Polls are open today from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. All registered voters are encouraged to review their Official Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlet (OSB/VIP) before going to vote.
