2013 GENERAL MUNICIPAL AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS

LOS ANGELES (May 6, 2013) – City Clerk June Lagmay announced today that in preparation for the May 21, 2013 General Municipal and Special Elections, the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division has secured 38 Collection Depot (Depot) locations throughout the election jurisdiction (i.e., City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles Unified School District, and the Los Angeles Community College District).

On Election Night, after the polls have closed, voted ballots will be taken from over 1,150 individual polling places to these 38 Depots. At the Depots, voted ballots will be bagged and transported to the Election Division Service Center located at Piper Technical Center, 555 Ramirez Street, Space 375, Los Angeles, CA 90012. The Election Division Service Center will serve as the central counting location for receipt and processing of all ballots on Election Night.
