LAST DAY TO APPLY FOR A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT
2013 GENERAL MUNICIPAL AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS

LOS ANGELES (May 9, 2013) — City Clerk June Lagmay announced today that applications for a Vote-By-Mail (VBM) ballot for the May 21, 2013 General Municipal and Special Elections must be received by the Office of the City Clerk - Election Division by **Tuesday, May 14, 2013 by 5:00 p.m.** The last day to apply for and vote a VBM ballot in person at the Election Division office is Monday, May 20, 2013 at 5:00 p.m.

VBM applications in Chinese, Hindi, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Tagalog, Thai, and Vietnamese are also available on the Election Division website.

Returning Voted Ballots

Voted VBM ballots may be dropped off at any polling place or received in the Election Division Office **by the close of polls (8:00 p.m.) on Election Day, May 21, 2013.** A postmarked date is not considered valid.

Voting in the Election Division office began Monday, April 22, 2013 and continues through Monday, May 20, 2013 at 5:00 p.m.
