**LOS ANGELES** (May 13, 2013) — City Clerk June Lagmay announced that the Office of the City Clerk will issue Election Night bulletins with unofficial results for candidates and measures for the May 21, 2013 City of Los Angeles General Municipal and Special Elections beginning at approximately 8:30 p.m.

The first bulletin on the evening of May 21 will contain results from the Vote-By-Mail ballots received and processed prior to Election Day. Subsequent bulletins will contain updated results from at-polls ballots as they come in throughout Election Night. A copy of the unofficial results bulletin format is attached for your reference.
