## 2013 GENERAL MUNICIPAL AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS

**LOS ANGELES** (May 14, 2013) — City Clerk June Lagmay reminds voters that the May 21, 2013 City of Los Angeles General Municipal and Special Elections **are just 7 days away**. All registered voters are encouraged to review their Official Sample Ballot and Voter Information Pamphlet (OSB/VIP) before going to vote.

The location of your polling place can be found on the back cover of your OSB/VIP or on our website. If your voting location has changed, a postcard has been mailed to you with the updated information. The polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
