LOS ANGELES (July 23, 2013) — City Clerk June Lagmay reminds voters in Council District 6 to get out and vote today, Tuesday, July 23, 2013, in the Council District 6 Special Runoff Election. Polls are open today from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. All registered voters are encouraged to review their Official Sample Ballot (OSB) before going to vote.
